

一天柳心胄介流柔術

ITTEN RYUSHIN CHUKAI RYU JUJUTSU

一天柳心胄介流柔術略歴

一天柳心胄介流柔術とは、小野惣吉が、一心流・柳心胄介流・天神真楊流の三流を合一して「一天柳心胄介流柔術」と名付けて一流儀としたものである。

小野惣吉は、宮城の岩沼の居住地において、柳心胄介流柔術の三浦義右エ衛門のもとで長年修行し免許を得た。

ある日、柳心胄介流柔術に勝る技量の持ち主である一心流柔術の佐久間勝左なる者が現れたので、小野はこの佐久間にも師事してその伝を受けた。

その後小野惣吉は上京し、天神真楊流柔術の吉田千春の門に入り、柔術と接骨を習得し、故郷の岩沼に帰り、接骨業を営みながら、三流を合一して「一天柳心胄介流柔術」（一心流の一と天神真楊流の天と柳心胄介流を合一）と称し、教授した。

昭和二十七年（1952）ころ、仙台近郊の多賀城市に居住していた佐藤金兵衛は、当時八十才位になっていたが元気いっばいの小野惣吉に教えうける事となり、全伝を受け、二代目を継承した。

ちなみに、佐藤金兵衛は、小野惣吉が師事した吉田千春の伝承者である宮本半蔵からも天神真楊流を教えられている。

平成四年（1992）五月、種村匠刀は、佐藤金兵衛より当流儀の免許皆傳を受け、三代目を継承した。また、種村は、佐藤金兵衛から天神真楊流柔術をも伝授されている。

この流儀の柔術は、立ち技が二十三本、居捕が六本、口伝入り身四本、口伝裸締め三本、口伝活法等である。この他、真言密法も加えられてある。

代系は次のとおり

Itten Ryushin Chukai Ryu Jujutsu History

Itten Ryushin Chukai Ryu Jujutsu was created by Ono Sokichi, who combined Isshin Ryu, Ryushin Chukai Ryu and Tenjin Shinyo Ryu into Itten Ryushin Chukai Ryu Jujutsu.

Ono Sokichi trained for many years under Miura Giemon, Grandmaster of Ryushin Chukai Ryu Jujutsu, staying at his residence in Iwanuma, Miyagi prefecture, where Ono received Menkyo, license of Grandmaster.

One day, Ono came into a man named Sakuma Shoza of Isshin Ryu Jujutsu, which excelled Ryushin Chukai Ryu Jujutsu, and then Ono Sokichi studied also under Sakuma and received the mastership from him. Afterwards, Ono Sokichi went to Tokyo and learned Tenjin Shinyo Ryu Jujutsu under Yoshida Chiharu. After he mastered the Jujutsu and osteopathy there, he returned to Iwanuma, his hometown, where he ran an osteopathic clinic, created his own Ryuha and taught it. He named his Ryuha "Itten Ryushin Chukai Ryu Jujutsu" because he combined the names of three Ryuha that he had learned.

Around 1952 or the 27th year of Showa era, Sato Kinbei, who was living in Tagajo City near Sendai, learned from Ono Sokichi, who was very energetic although he was about 80 years old. Then, Sato succeeded in mastering all the techniques and was appointed as the 2nd Grandmaster of Itten Ryushin Chukai Ryu Jujutsu.

Incidentally, Sato Kinbei was also taught Tenjin Shinyo Ryu by Miyamoto Hanzo, the successor to Yoshida Chiharu, who had instructed Ono Sokichi in the art of Tenjin Shinyo Ryu Jujutsu.

In May 1992 or the 4th year of Heisei era, Tanemura Shoto received his Menkyo Kaiden, or the full proficiency, of this Ryuha from Sato Kinbei and became the 3rd Grandmaster. Tanemura also learned Tenjin Shinyo Ryu from Kinbei Sato.

Itten Ryushin Chukai Ryu Jujutsu has 23 standing techniques, 6 Idori style patterns, 4 Kuden Irimi styles, 3 Kuden Hadakajime styles and some Kuden Kappo styles. Moreover, Shingon Mippo is also added to this Jujutsu.
